Collegiate awards a limited number of Merit Scholarships each year to qualified candidates who demonstrate superior academic achievement, deep engagement in extracurricular life and outstanding character and citizenship. In addition to a financial award of up to \$6,000, the Merit Scholarship program starts with a trip to Vanderbuilt University in 9th grade and is followed by several experiential opportunities through senior year.

Recognition as a recipient of the Merit Scholarship is a highly selective honor that recognizes outstanding students based on:

- Superior academic achievement
- Outstanding character
- The potential for making a significant contribution as a citizen of Collegiate and the global community

- 2. A completed ninth-grade application including all supporting documents (manage the process in the admission portal)
- 3. The admission assessment and essay on January 9 or 23, 2021.
