PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Collaborative spirit in developing curricula and teaching methods, both within the department and across other disciplines
- Willingness to provide extra help for students of all ranges and abilities daily during available office hours
- Understanding of the developmental needs of upper school students
- Enthusiastic involvement in the school community outside the classroom
- Proven positive working relationships with colleagues, students, and families
- Excellent communication skills, both written and oral
- Proven organizational skills
- Experience with block schedules preferred

ADDITIONAL RESPONSIBILITIES AS REQUIRED:

- Serve as faculty advisor to ten to fifteen upper school students
- Coach or lead extra-curricular activities as agreed upon with the Head of the Upper School
- Serve as a member of the History Department, attending departmental meetings, developing and updating course curricula, and supporting the work of the department
